Our focus is on the future and one conclusion can be drawn: The information world is shifting rapidly and we are finding it hard to catch up and be in a position to master these powerful and exciting changes. The themes of the conference are focused on “e”-developments, their all-pervading presence and the impact they have on us.

The sub-topics:

E-media in Motion

There is hardly any information left that is available in analogue formats only. An increasing amount of data is accessible through digital media only. The devices being used to get access to information are developing rapidly. The world of mobile devices, cross media, augmented reality, learning through games instead of books, semantic web and new search techniques is a challenging and dynamic one.

My Information

Organizations are adapting to the world around us; they have to! The globalised world demands us to find new ways of collaborating, learning and working. And as a result of that, we will have to find alternative ways and tools to record and archive our information.
