Developing an easily understandable learning platform that is tailored to the needs of primary schools.

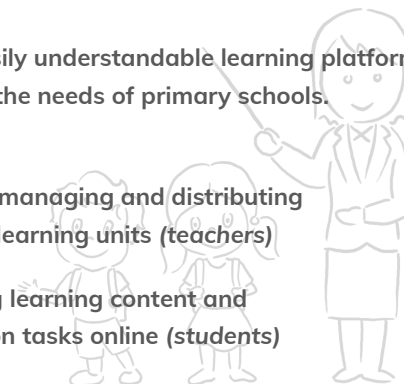

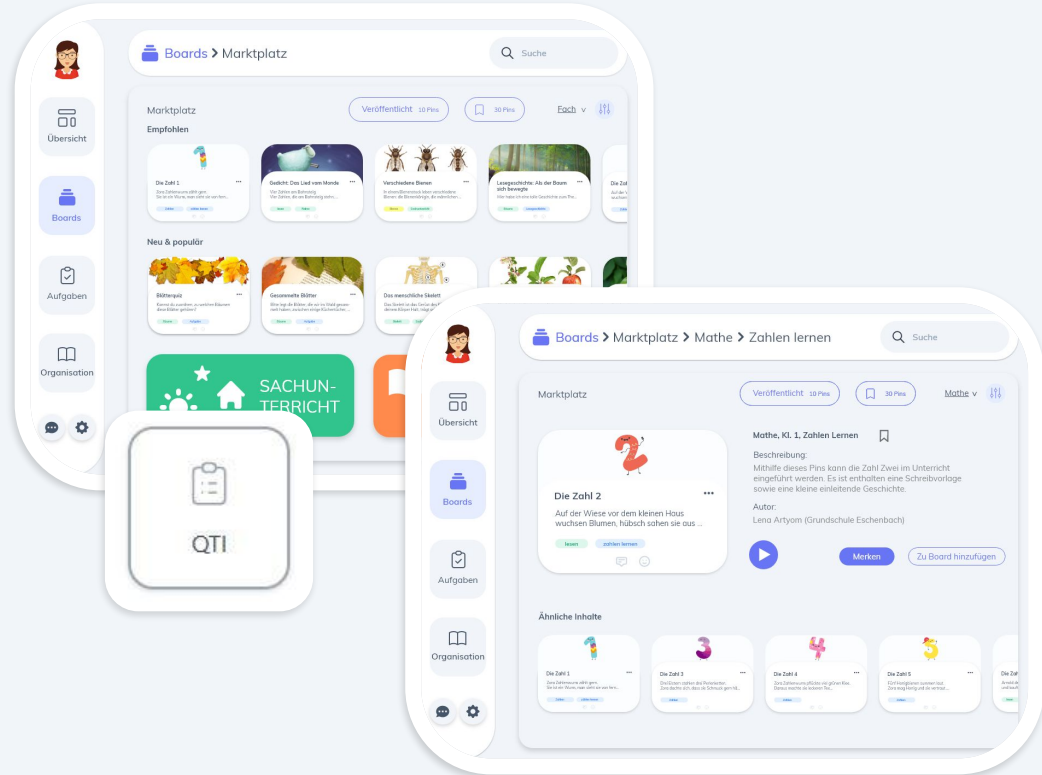


Motivation:
