

HdMSurvey is a survey platform of Hochschule der Medien, based on the software LimeSurvey. The following steps are mandatory in order to create, conduct and complete a basic survey on HdMSurvey.

1. Create a new survey

define the survey title and language

2. Set the basic settings under "Settings" (Einstellungen)



- General settings:** Clearly state the contact details of the person responsible for the survey (name + email)
- Text elements:** Enter welcome message & end message
- Privacy policy:** enter and display a text for privacy policy – if consent to data processing is required (otherwise at least provide notice of the types of data and processing in the welcome message)

3. Design the survey content under "Structure" (Struktur)



- Add question pages (groups) and questions
- Check your survey in the preview

4. Conduct the survey

- Activate the survey
- Send/publish the link to the survey (under "Overview")

5. Complete the survey

- Stop the survey (option "Expire" or set an end date)
- Evaluate or export the results

6. Delete the survey

- Delete it yourself or b)
- Automatic deletion: 6 months after survey end date
